1. **Using point form**, please describe how the candidate meets the following criteria:
  - A. Innovation** – Innovator’s business will address an unmet need in their market
  - B. Community Focused** – Innovators will have demonstrated volunteerism, philanthropy, service above self, and contribute to the local economy
  - C. Values** – Innovators approach their work with passion, honesty, integrity and excellence
2. **A bio and/or updated curriculum vitae must be attached to your nomination.**
3. The submission of additional materials that support your nomination is encouraged. These could include:
  - Documentary support such as newspaper and magazine articles, or reference to journals, publications, and coverage in the electronic media
  - Awards, nominations for awards, participation in relevant competitions
  - Letters of support, including the names, titles, addresses and contact information of individuals that support this nomination (individual or corporate)
4. The selected nominee **must** agree to be present at the Waterloo Region Entrepreneur Hall of Fame Gala.
