- Be able to attend the gala, which will be held on May 8, 2024, to assist with the silent auction (set up if possible) and checkout
- Assist in promotion of the event through sharing on your social media, networking, etc.

Volunteer Qualifications

- Must be 18 years or older to volunteer
- Must be available for a volunteer interview and complete all screening requirements, including a Police Records Check
